



Run Timing — Kenai, Soldotna, Homer

Peak of the run is in the middle of the dates given

Kenai River	King Salmon	Early run: mid-May to early July. Late run: early July to season closure late July or early August.
	Red Salmon	Mid-July to mid-August.
	Silver Salmon	Late July to late September.
	Pink Salmon	Mid-July to August
Russian River	Red Salmon	Early run: mid-June to mid-July Late run: mid-July to season closure late August.
Kasilof River	King Salmon	Late May to season closure late July.
	Red Salmon	June through August.
	Silver Salmon	Late July through September.
Anchor River, Deep Creek Ninilchik River	King Salmon	Late May to mid-June.
	Silver Salmon	Early August to mid-September
Anchor River	Steelhead Trout	Mid-August to early November (catch-and-release only)
Deep Creek Salt Water	King Salmon	Early run: early May to late June Late run: late June to early August
	King Salmon	Mid-May to early July
Homer Spit	Silver Salmon	Early run: Mid-July to early August Late run: Early August to mid-September
	Dolly Varden	Mid-May to mid-July
	King Salmon	Mid-May to early July
Halibut Cove	King Salmon	Mid-May to early July
Clam Gulch, Deep Creek, and Polly Creek	Razor Clams	All year, on minus-2 foot tides or lower.
